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## Banbury Campus Homework Policy- 2020-2021 (Updated March 2021)

### Year 7 and 8- Details of Homework

Year 7 and 8 homework comprises of **three** tasks, totalling approx. 45 minutes each evening- Monday to Thursday. The breakdown of these tasks is shown in Table 1. Students will need to plan their time effectively as they will work on tasks across the week and across the term.

### Task 1: Creative Projects

For Year 7 and 8 students, there will be termly creative projects set by the following departments: Art, English, History, Geography and Science. All details of which will be sent out at the beginning of each project via Google Classroom. Students need to plan their time and ensure they spend at least 20 mins on this every evening. There will be staggered deadlines for these projects and departments will outline those on the task sheet given to students. The projects will involve developing a range of skills and developing students' knowledge in those subject areas.

### Task 2: Complete Maths- Online Tool

Year 7 and 8 students will be set three quizzes a week using the online tool 'Complete Maths'. These quizzes will take approximately 15 mins each and relate clearly to the content taught in Maths that week. There will be a weekly assignment set on Google Classroom outlining the 'Complete Maths' details for that week.

### Task 3: Languages Vocabulary

Year 7 and 8 students will be tested weekly on their Languages vocabulary via a Google Form Quiz. Students will have a weekly vocabulary list to learn and then a follow up themed quiz to check their understanding.

### Year 9, 10 and 11 Homework Details

Years 9, 10 and 11 will be set two main tasks across the week- Complete Maths tasks and subject homework. There will be denoted days when English, Maths and Science will be set in order to help students plan their time. Each subject task should take no longer than 20 minutes.

Students will then need to complete their homework timetable with option subject teachers so they know when option subject homework will be set each week.

### Task 1: Subject Homework

Students will be set one piece of subject homework a week in the subjects outlined above. Tasks will be set on a specific day each week, depending on when subjects are taught and due in on the same day the following week. The subject homework tasks will be a mixture of contextual research, knowledge quizzing, planning and other tasks related to revision and developing knowledge. There will be no lengthy extended writing tasks for homework. All homework tasks will be uploaded on Google Classroom for students. Parents will be notified through email of set homework tasks and students' completion/non completion if they have agreed to receiving the Google Guardian updates. Students must hand in homework via Google Classroom, either as a Google document or as a photo attachment.

### Task 2: Complete Maths- Online Tool

Year 9 – 11 students will be assigned 'Complete Maths' tasks weekly, the number of which is denoted in the above table. These tasks will be quizzes related to taught content that week. In

addition to this, in years 10 and 11, the students will also receive a weekly 20 minute Maths subject homework task.

### **Year 12 and 13**

Students will complete an hour of private study for every hour they are in the classroom.

This will consist of exam questions, research, note-making, general revision and coursework.

### **Rewards and Sanctions**

Students will be rewarded for their excellent homework via achievement points and Rewards Assemblies.

The below outlines the new sanction system for students who have not completed homework tasks.

**This will not begin until week beginning 19<sup>th</sup> April**

#### **New Sanction Details**

##### **Step 1-**

Student misses a deadline for homework. Please warn them and make clear that it needs to be handed in the following lesson/day.

##### **Step 2-**

Student still does not submit the work. Please log on SIMS as 'incomplete homework' and notify Head of Subject so a standard email can be sent to parents via schoolcomms. (The standard email will be held with Lisa Palmer and she can send out once notified by Head of Subject.)

##### **Step 3-**

If the student still does not complete the work despite email letter home- referred to Head of Year and will go on green report with targets specific to homework.

##### **Step 4-**

If student fails green report- 15 min detention after school with Head of Year/Assistant Head of Year and escalate to orange report

##### **Step 5-**

If student fails orange report- kept for half an hour after school and escalate to red report

##### **Step 6-**

Students on red report will be monitored closely by the year group team and further sanctions/support needed identified in addition to conversations with parents/carers.
