Vaccinations

We have been told this week that students in our school will be offered their flu and Covid inoculations on the 4th October (Year 7, 8 and 9) and the 14th October (Year 10 and 11). Please note that vaccinations happen at school because this is where the children are together en masse and that we have nothing to do with the gaining of consent from families other than providing the details of who is on roll at school. We have received a number of messages from concerned parents who are worried we have a role to play in the consent process. We do not play any role.

We have also launched the next school show with students and the auditions are underway. 

Some key reminders for all parents/carers

- School starts at 8.40 a.m. and students should be in mentor time by 8.45 a.m. 1.
