# Roblox servers crash leaving the website down for nearly 72 hours

On Thursday, 28th October 2021, Roblox crashed at around 11:30 pm BST. This caused players to be kicked from their current experiences and leaving just a few from countries not yet affected remaining in play.

Roblox later confirmed that no games were the cause of the shutdown, thus "shut down" any rumours that the Chipotle Boorito event. The cause of the shutdown was still unknown.

Almost 48-hours after the initial crash, Roblox announced they had found

24-hours later, the American servers began to work, soon, the British servers were up.

The shutdown caused many developers to lose over \$20,000 USD. Bigger developer companies lost a significant amount of money that would have had to have been paid out as wages to their staff.

#### **3 TIPS TO IMPROVE ON STUDENT WELLBEING**


- 1.Go to bed earlier than usual so that you get more sleep.

The Legend of Podkin One-ear is a fantastic book written by Kieran Larwood and illustrated by David Wyatt and the first book in the five realms series.


