Dear Parent/Carer

You will have seen the news and the change in threat level of Covid to a 4. We remain committed to ensuring that we reduce the risk of transmission as much as we can by encouraging members of the school community to wear face coverings whilst in communal areas, by opening windows and doors to ventilate shared spaces and by taking lateral flow tests regularly. Please support us by explaining to your children the reasons why we follow these precautions.

This is the latest guidance from the government which is due to come into force today:

Daily testing for contacts of COVID-19

From Tuesday 14 December, a new national approach to daily testing for contacts of COVID-19 is being introduced (including until the end of this term). All adults who are fully vaccinated and children aged 5 to 18 years and 6 months, identified as a contact of someone with COVID-19 – whether Omicron or not – should take a lateral flow device (LFD) test every day for 7 days instead of self-isolating. Daily testing by close contacts will help to slow the spread of COVID-19.

Daily testing for contacts of COVID-19 will help protect education settings by reducing transmission and will also help keep pupils in face-to-face education.

Can you please support your child to take a LFT on Tuesday night and Wednesday night please so that we reduce the chance of transmission in the last two days of term.

Testing after Christmas for the spring term

You will also be aware that we are required to carry out testing again of all students on our return from the Christmas holidays.
